

CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS

« PONTIAC DNA »

1. CONTEST ORGANIZER

The Pontiac DNA Contest is held and organized by the MRC Pontiac (hereinafter referred to as the "MRC" or the "Organizer").

2. DURATION OF THE CONTEST

The contest takes place in Quebec from September 16, 2020 at 8:00 a.m. (ET) to October 28, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. (ET) (hereinafter referred to as the "Contest Period").

3. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible to enter the contest, a person must:

- Be a resident of a Canadian province or territory;
- Have reached the legal age in accordance with the laws of their province or territory of residence at the time of entering the contest.

4. HOW TO PARTICIPATE

Participation in this contest is free and without obligation of purchase. To participate in this contest, a person must meet the eligibility requirements and other conditions set out in these rules. Subject to the limitations contained in these rules, there are two (2) ways to participate during the Contest Period:

1. To participate in the contest, an eligible person must have completed and transmitted the form for the public consultation by the MRC Pontiac, via <https://www.visagesregionaux.com/consultation-publique/>
2. To participate in the contest, an eligible person must have completed and transmitted the MRC Pontiac's public consultation form (paper format) to administration at their local municipal office.

5. DESCRIPTION OF THE PRIZE

The contest prize contains the following items:

- 1st prize: a stay at Bryson Lake Lodge.
Value of 500\$
- 2nd prize: a gift basket of local Pontiac products
Value of 200\$

Total prize value: \$700

Some date restrictions may apply.

6. SPECIAL CONDITIONS RELATED TO PRIZES

Prizes are non-refundable and non-transferable.

7. DRAW

7.1 There will be a random draw from all eligible entries received for the prize. The draw will take place on October 29, 2020 at 1:00 p.m. (ET), before a witness from among the employees of the MRC Pontiac, at the MRC Pontiac office in Campbell's Bay.

7.2. The awarding of the prizes is limited to one prize per person.

7.3. The MRC reserves the right to disqualify a person or cancel an entry that does not comply with these rules.

8. LIMITATION OF PARTICIPATION AND EXCLUSIONS

8.1. The number of entries per person is limited according to the provisions of clause 4 of this set of rules.

8.2. Employees, agents, directors and representatives of the MRC and its affiliates, as well as all persons with whom they are domiciled, are excluded from the contest.

8.3. Also excluded are agents and affiliated agencies, their employees and the persons with whom they are domiciled.

9. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

To be declared a winner, the randomly selected entrant must meet the following additional conditions:

- Be reached by telephone by the Organizer in order to be informed of the terms and conditions for the awarding of the prize within 5 business days following the draw;
- The selected entrant must be reached within a maximum of 2 attempts and will have 5 days to call the Contest Organizer back following the message left in his/her voice mailbox, if applicable, failing which he/she will lose his/her right to the prize;
- Confirm that he/she meets the eligibility and other requirements of these rules.

9.1 Failure to comply with any of the above conditions or to accept the prize will result in disqualification and a new random draw will be conducted in accordance with these rules, until an eligible entrant is selected and declared a winner. If no entrant is declared a winner within thirty (30) days of the original draw, the Organizer will have the right to cancel the prize.

9.2. Verification

Entries are subject to verification by the Contest Organizer. Any entry or attempted entry that is, as the case may be, fraudulent, illegible, incomplete, received late or otherwise not in compliance with the Rules and Regulations will be rejected and will not entitle the entrant to an entry or prize, as the case may be. The decision of the Contest Organizer with respect to any aspect of this contest, including but not limited to the eligibility or disqualification of entries, will be final and without appeal, subject to the decision of the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec with respect to a matter under its jurisdiction.

9.3. Disqualification

The Contest Organizer reserves the right to disqualify a person or cancel one or more entries from a person if that person enters or attempts to enter this contest in a manner that is contrary to these contest rules or is unfair to other entrants. This person may be referred to the competent legal authorities, if necessary. The decision of the Contest Organizer to this effect is final and without appeal.

9.4. Acceptance of the prize

The prize must be accepted as described in these rules and may not be transferred in whole or in part to another person, except as otherwise provided for in these rules.

9.5. Limitation of liability - use of the prize

The prize winner releases the Contest Organizer, its advertising and promotional agencies, their employees, agents and representatives from any liability for any damage, prejudice or loss that he or she may suffer as a result of the acceptance or use of his or her prize. Each selected entrant acknowledges that, from the moment he/she is informed of the terms and conditions for the awarding of his/her prize, the performance of the obligations related to the prize becomes the sole and exclusive responsibility of the various suppliers of products and services.

9.6. Limitation of liability - operation

The Contest Organizer, its advertising and promotional agencies, its employees, agents and representatives disclaim all liability arising from the malfunctioning of any computer component, software or communication line, with respect to the loss or absence of network communication or with respect to any transmission that is faulty, incomplete, incomprehensible or erased by any computer or network that could limit or prevent a person's ability to participate in the contest.

9.7. Limitation of liability - registration

The Contest Organizer, its advertising and promotional agencies, its employees, agents and representatives disclaim all liability for any damage or loss that may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, by the downloading of any Internet page or software and by the transmission of any information related to participation in this contest.

9.8. Modification of the contest

The Contest Organizer reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend, in whole or in part, this contest in the event of an event or any human intervention that could corrupt or affect the administration, security, impartiality or conduct of the contest, as provided for in these rules, subject to the authorization of the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux du Québec, if required. In all cases, the Contest Organizer, its subsidiaries, advertising and promotional agencies, its suppliers of products or services related to this contest, as well as its employees, agents and representatives may not be required to award more prizes or award one or more prizes otherwise than in accordance with these rules.

9.9. Authorization

The winner of the prize authorizes the Contest Organizer and its representatives to use, if required, his or her name, photograph, image, voice, contact information, place of residence or a statement relating to their prize for publicity purposes, without any form of compensation.

9.10. Participant

For the purposes of these rules, the eligible entrant is recognized as the person identifying himself/herself on the entry form and it is to this person that the prize will be awarded if he/she is selected and declared a winner.

9.11. Limitation of prizes

In all cases, the Organizer may not be required to award more prizes or to award a prize otherwise than in accordance with these rules.

9.12. Limitation of liability - participation

The person who enters or attempts to enter this Contest releases the Contest Organizer, its advertising and promotional agencies, its subsidiaries, its employees, agents and representatives from any and all liability for any damages that he or she may suffer as a result of his or her participation or attempt to participate in this Contest.

9.13. Copy of the rules

9.14. Dispute

Any litigation respecting the conduct or organization of this publicity contest may be submitted to the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux for a ruling. Any litigation respecting the awarding of a prize may be submitted to the Régie only for the purpose of helping the parties reach a settlement.
